

Noah Obey's God's Big Plan



Lesson 1: Listening and Building

“*Noah did everything God commanded him to do.*”

— Genesis 6:22

The Bible tells us about a man named Noah who loved God. At that time, many people on earth were making bad choices. But Genesis 6:9 says, "Noah was a godly man. He was the only person on earth who lived right. He walked faithfully with God."

God was sad about the world and decided to send a great flood. But He wanted to save Noah and his family. So, God gave Noah a huge and very special job. He said, "So make yourself an ark out of cypress wood" (Genesis 6:14). God gave him exact instructions on how to build it—how big, how many doors, and what to put inside. He also told Noah to gather two of every kind of animal to be safe on the boat.

This job would take a very long time, and people probably thought Noah was silly for building a giant boat with no rain in sight. But Noah trusted God completely. The Bible says, "Noah did everything God commanded him to do" (Genesis 6:22). Because he obeyed, his family and the animals were saved from the flood. Noah's story teaches us that obeying God keeps us safe and shows we trust Him, even when the instructions seem strange.
